

Disaster Preparedness Manual for Students

Please keep this with you at all times in case of disaster

In case of a major earthquake

A. When you are on campus

1. In a classroom

♦When it starts to shake

1) Remain calm, do not run outside. Take cover under a desk, etc., until the shaking stops.

2) If there is nothing to hide under, avoid anything which may fall, drop, or move in your direction, such as bookshelves, light fixtures, etc. Stay low and protect your head with your bag or clothes.

3) Leave the door open to ensure an exit. Avoid windows, as the glass may shatter.

4) In a hallway and gym, crouch down in the center area.

♦After the shaking stops

- 1) If during class, follow the directions of the teaching staff and evacuate.
- 2) Do not run outside, check if it is safe around you.
- 3) Turn off any gas or pilots to prevent fire.
- 4) In case of fire, evacuate immediately.
- 5) When evacuating, watch for any falling items and broken glass.
- 6) Do not use the elevator, and stay together as a group as much as possible.

2. When outdoors

♦When it starts to shake

- 1) Move away from any buildings, stay down and protect your head.
- 2) If you are in a car, leave the keys in the ignition, open the door and get out.

♦After the shaking stops

- 1) Check if it is safe before moving.
- 2) Next, evacuate and try not to approach any nearby buildings, walls, or fissures (cracks in the ground).

*refer to the map in the back for evacuation sites at the university.

First, evacuate to a primary evacuation site. After it has been confirmed safe, move to the secondary (final) evacuation site, and wait.

B. When you are off campus

- 1) Do not move unnecessarily and ensure your safe.
- 2) Follow the directions of the police and fire department and evacuate.
- 3) Follow other general disaster prevention manuals and evacuate.

C. To protect yourself from a tsunami (Sakai City area)

After a strong quake, or if a major tsunami alarm is issued

1) Evacuate on foot to higher ground (6.8m above sea level), heading for JR Hanwa Line.

2) If you are unable to evacuate immediately or travel very far, evacuate to higher ground, such as a designated tsunami evacuation building.

In case of fire

- 1) Warn those around you with a loud voice and evacuate.
- 2) Push the nearest emergency fire alarm.
- 3) When evacuating, cover your nose and mouth with a handkerchief, etc., stay low and avoid inhaling the smoke.
- 4) Do not use elevator.
- 5) Do not rush to the exit and evacuate in an orderly fashion.
- 6) In case of a blackout, evacuate by heading towards the lighted exit signs.

◆Things to always keep in mind

- 1) Know the locations of the local evacuation sites in advance.
- 2) Prepare an emergency bag using the evacuation items list.
- 3) Confirm how to contact family members and where to meet in advance.
- 4) Confirm the route to go home and how much time it takes.
- 5) Register to the disaster message board service.





If you find a person who appears to be unconscious

How to perform resuscitation

If you dial 119, you can be instructed on what you should do via telephone. Even if you are not trained in resuscitation methods, try to remain calm and follow the instructions.

1. Check if the person is conscious or not

- · Pat the person's shoulder and speak to him/her
- · If there is no response, call an ambulance (dial 119).
- · If an AED is available, ask someone to bring it to the scene.

2. Check if the person is breathing or not

- · Check if the chest or abdomen is moving.
- · If not, consider it to be a case of cardiac arrest.

3. Do chest compressions (heart massage)

- Put one hand on top of the other on the center of the chest and push the chest strongly at least 30 times.
- Push the chest strongly to a depth of at least 5 centimeters.
- · The speed should be at least 100 times per minute.

4. How to use an AED (automated external defibrillator)

- \cdot Switch on the AED.
- · Follow the voice instructions.
- · Attach the electrode pads to the person.




