Advantages



- International experience at home

The newly constructed International House is designed to promote interactions between residents, like those in a shared house, in which residents share a self-contained unit while having their own private rooms.

- Security

Auto-lock system (No curfew, 24-hour-a-day access)

House manager support available (12:00-20:00 on weekdays, national holidays, August 15 and New Year's holidays)

Call center support available in multiple languages at night and on Saturday and Sunday.



Rules



Concerning use of the International House (hereinafter, "House"), there are rules for the residents to follow. If your application for the House is accepted, you will receive the "Guidebook for Residents." Violation of these rules written in the Guidebook may lead to your expulsion from the House.

- Ban on nuisances

Do not cause nuisances (making noise, fighting, leaving garbage behind, etc.) for local residents around the Campus, and other residents of the House.

- Residents' rooms & shared facilities

Clean your room and other facilities to maintain hygiene.

- The House is off-limits to visitors. Visitors are not allowed to enter any resident's room.

Meet your visitors in the Lobby Lounge.

- Prohibition against lodging of visitors

You are not allowed to let any visitors, even your friends or parents, stay the night at the House.

- ┆ The other gender's units are off-limits.

The men's units and women's units are separated in the House. Residents are not allowed to enter the other gender's units.

- ┆ Smoking

Smoking in residents' rooms and on House premises is prohibited.

- ┆ Drinking

Drinking alcohol in residents' rooms and on House premises is prohibited.

- ┆ Pets

Rearing or owning a pet in the House is prohibited. You are not allowed to keep a pet in the House under any circumstances.
